And the sound of music

The festival city of Salzburg is a starting point and urban highlight of this tour. Known worldwide for Mozartkugeln and 'The Sound of Music', the city on the Salzach has a lot to offer, for example, the delightful old town and the imposing Hohensalzburg Fortress.

From A for Abbey (Michaelbeuren) to Z for Zoo (Hellbrunn) – a whole alphabet of highlights awaits on the Ten Lakes Tour. Nature lovers get their money's worth on this tour. The Ibmer Moor nature reserve, the deep blue Fuschlsee or the Salzachauen offer relaxation for the senses. From a cultural point of view, you can look forward to the 'Silent Night' town of Oberndorf, the 'Mozart village' of St. Gilgen and the Kaiservilla in Bad Ischl.

Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival in Salzburg or at the Trumer Seen lakes

Information on the tour and bike fitting. In the case of those arriving at the Trumer Seen lakes, the subsequent daily tours are moved accordingly in the itinerary (these guests begin the tour with the route described for the third day, cycling the Salzburg - Trumer Seen lakes route on the final day).

Day 2 Salzburg – Ibmer Moor | approx. 45 km

Today, you will cycle along the river Salzach to Oberndorf, the birthplace of the Christmas carol "Silent Night". You will cycle through the Salzach meadows to the moor lakes of the Ibmer Moor, lake Höllerersee and Lake Holzöstersee.

Day 3 Ibmer Moor – Trumer Seen/Lake Wallersee | approx. 30-45 km

The day will start with a tour through the nature reserve Ibmer Moor to the Benedictine abbey Michaelbeuern. You can either cycle around or over mount Haunsberg to the Trumer Seen lakes (lakes Grabensee, Mattsee, and Obertrumersee) or to Lake Wallersee.

Day 4 Trumer Seen lakes/Lake Wallersee – Lake Attersee/Lake Mondsee | approx. 50 km

On the third day, the tour will take you through the nature reserve of the Egelseen lakes to Schleedorf (model village and cheese-maker). Later, you will continue to the idyllic Lake Irrsee. Overnight stay in Mondsee (castle, smokehouse) or Attersee.

Day 5 Lake Attersee/Mondsee – Lake Traunsee | approx. 50-80 km

The day begins with a boat trip to Weyregg (make sure to note the dates for the season!). Afterwards, you will cycle through the Aurachtal valley to Lake Traunsee with Gmunden (castle Orth, ceramics factory), Altmünster (bicycle museum), and Traunkirchen ("Fishermen's Pulpit").

Day 6**Lake Traunsee – Lake Hallstättersee – Bad Goisern/surrounding**

approx. 20-35 km

By train you will go from Lake Traunsee up to Obertraun at Lake Hallstättersee (Dachstein mountainous ice caves). Later, you will continue along the lake to Hallstatt ("the loveliest lakeside location in the world", the oldest salt mine). Your today's destination is Bad Goisern or one of the neighbouring towns.

Day 7**Bad Goisern/surrounding area – Lake Wolfgangsee**

approx. 35 km

Via Bad Ischl (Emperor's Park, Emperor's Villa, Empress Sissi's Teahouse) you will cycle along the Ischler Ache river to Lake Wolfgangsee: You will come through places such as St. Wolfgang (White Horse Inn, parish church, cog railway on to the Schafberg), Strobl, Lake Abersee (Zinkenbachklamm gorge) and St. Gilgen - the Mozart village on Lake Wolfgangsee.

Day 8**Lake Wolfgangsee – Salzburg**

approx. 50-70 km

On the seventh day, you will take the cycle route to St. Gilgen ("Mozart Village"), the hiking trail into the Tiefbrunnau, past the Hintersee lake, and the Strubklamm gorge into the Wiestal valley (dam); You will come through the Glaserbachklamm into the Salzachtal valley. Shortly before reaching Salzburg, it is worth visiting the castle Schloss Hellbrunn (park, zoo, water games). Your destination is the festival and Mozart city of Salzburg with its numerous attractions (fortress, old town).

Day 9**Departure or extension of trip**

Individual return journey or extension.

The route

Along the lakes and river Salzach on cycle paths, flat. In between you are cycling on undulating sections in green rolling countryside. About 1/3rd of the route on dedicated cycle paths, almost all of the rest on country roads, forest lanes and quiet minor roads. Only a few and short sections are on roads with more traffic.
