











Bike tour in Germany and Netherlands

Cycling in the East Frisian and the Netherlands

East Frisia and Holland are very well known as being ideal cycle territories. Green plains, canals, wooded hills, dykes, the sea and lively little towns are characteristic for this country. Enjoy the tranquility and the local hospitality and immerse into seemingly endless countryside. Culture and tradition are part of daily life. The route crosses the border to lively town Groningen, the river-boats of Dollart of Delfzijl, to Ditzum. You cycle past stately windmills and white drawbridges. Enjoy a cycle tour through the unique scenery along the North Sea.

Day 1 Individual arrival to Emden

Individual arrival in Emden. In the late afternoon you will have your information meeting and the bike handover (if booked). The seaport is the home to several museum ships. If you like fish, you should try Matjes or prawns here.

Day 2 Emden – Leer approx. 35 km

Enjoy the first ride from Emden to Petkum on beautiful paths. By ferry (not included) you reach the village of Ditzum where you should visit the fish harbour. Along the river Ems you cycle via Jemgum to Leer. Discover the beautiful and old city centre, the picturesque baroque building and the harbour.

Day 3 Leer – Papenburg



Bicycle tour through the Moormer region, the heart of the Fehn culture. Wind and range accompany you on your way to Papenburg. Papenburg is called the "Venice of the Nother". An exceptional attraction of Papenburg is the company "Meyer Werft", which build cruise ships. Day 4

Papenburg – Stadskanaal

approx. 55 km

Immediately behind Papenburg you enter the Netherlands, province Groningen. After a couple of kilometres visit the old, star-formed border fortress Bourtange from the 16th century. Then you cycle through fertile marshes to Stadskanaal, past huge farms and renovated old locks.

Day 5

Stadskanaal – Groningen

approx. 45 km

Solitary cycle path through dense forests, heather, moor and peat you cycle through province Drenthe. You cycle through idyllic villages to Ziudlaren with splendid Saxon farmhouses and late-Romanesque church. Only a brief distance along the large continental-lake Paterswoldsemeer and you reach the city Groningen.



Groningen – Delfzijl

approx. 60 km

Groningen is a lively centre in the North-East of the Netherland and is well worth a visit, before you set off to the North. Here you are soon embraced by quietude and solitariness. Near Uithuizen you find the most beautiful fortress of the region Groningen, Menkemaburg. Along the dyke you cycle to Delfzijl.

Day 7 Delfzijl – Emden approx. 20 – 50 km

Option 1: (Arrival everyday): Cycle tour to Delfzijl along the Dollart. From Ditzum to Petkum by ferry and cycle tour to Emden (approx. 50 km)

Option 2: (only on Sunday arrival): From Delfzijl along the Dollart to Emden-Knock by ferry and cycle tour to Emden. (approx. 20 – 50 km)

Day 8 Departure

Individual Departure or additional overnight.

The route

East Frisia and the Netherlands are ideal countrysides for cycle tours. All routes are flat! You cycle on asphalted or plastered country lanes, sometimes on minor roads. This road is perfectly suited for beginners or groups.

Departure from Delfzijl around 10:50 am and 4:50 pm, trip duration approx. 1h 15 minutes. Please contact us in good time before your arrival or www.dollard-route.de. Cycling distance from Emden harbor to your hotel approx. 4 km. All ferry crossings are not included in the price.
