# La Route Royale

This cycling tour leads you into the romantic Loire valleys and its tributaries, into the ,Garden of France' and is totally characterised by royal residences built here centuries ago. Kings, overlords and court ladies seduced by the scenic allure of the region, took up residence here – and left their marks, which are best followed by bike: Villandry with its marvellous grounds, the ,Sleeping Beauty Palace' Ussé, the royal abbey of Fontevraud, which was at times used as a prison, the spectacular Chenonceaux palace, built on top of the foundations of a watermill situtated directly into the river Cher ... One fascinating, one-of-a-kind building followed by the next. Inbetween vineyards and wine villages oozing rural charm cover the area.

Adventurous cyclists get their money's worth and take plenty of time escpeically for Chambord palace and the numerous sights of Blois and Amboise. Without any pressure you cycle from palace to palace, delight in the stupendous architecture and revel in the royal sense of life of a region, where the wealthy and powerful of days gone by used to abnadon themselves to idleness and where you too will feel just like you live in clover.

# Itinerary

#### **Arrival Tours** Day 1

Individual arrival in Blois. The rental bikes (if booked) are available for you at the hotel.

#### **Blois - Amboise** approx. 45 km Day 2

The Loire cycle path takes you from Blois to Chaumont-sur-Loire. The castle here was never a royal residence and is therefore an insider tip. The park in particular is well worth a visit. You cycle on to Amboise. You are welcome to visit the castle, a particularly early example of Renaissance architecture in the Loire Valley. One overnight stay in Amboise.

#### Day 3 Amboise - Tours approx. 30 km

This stage leads through the vineyards on the slopes above the Loire, into the wine-growing region of Montlouis-sur-Loire and the small town of the same name, which is idyllically situated on the river. It is worth taking a short break here before returning to Tours, now again along the banks of the river. One overnight stay in Tours.

#### Tours - Chinon approx. 55 km Day 4

The River Cher takes you to Villandry Castle with its famous terraced gardens and ornate vegetable gardens. A few kilometers later, the Loire castle of Langeais and, on the edge of the forest of Chinon, the Sleeping Beauty castle of Ussé beckon. You approach today's destination of Chinon via small villages.

## Day 5

Trip Fontevraud l'Abbaye

approx. 55 km

Along the Vienne via Candes-St-Martin and Montsoreau. Past the famous monastery of Fontevraud l'Abbaye back to Chinon.

Day 6

Chinon - Azay-le-Rideau approx. 40 km

Azay-le-Rideau Castle is a diamond with a thousand facets, set in the Indre River - as Balzac wrote. You will spend the night directly in the village and have the opportunity to enjoy the magic of the castle and its cultural events.

#### Day 7

Azay-le-Rideau - Chenonceaux

approx. 60 km

Through the romantic river landscape of the Indre to Montbazon. On "meadow paths" along the Cher to Bléré, a small market town, and on to Chenonceau Castle.

### Day 8

Chenonceaux - Blois

approx. 50 - 80 km

Today you have two options to choose from: the shorter stage through Touraine to Chaumont Castle and on along the Loire to Blois, or the second, longer option: via Montrichard, Cheverny, Villesavine to Chambord Castle, the largest residence on the Loire. One overnight stay in Blois.

Day 9

Trip to the castle Chambord

approx. 50 km


Today is primarily dedicated to Chambord Castle. Even from a distance, this largest and most magnificent residence on the Loire shimmers through the trees. Half a millennium of French history has left its mark on Chambord: Built in the Renaissance under the art-loving King François I, the scene of glittering festivals and hunting parties under the "Sun King" Louis XIV, plundered during the French Revolution and today, after Versaille, the second most visited castle in France. Another overnight stay in Blois.

## Day 10 Departure or extension

C'est la vie – today your journey to the castles of the Loire has come to an end! One more substantial breakfast, then it's time to say goodbye to one of the most charming, delightful regions of France. Should you decide to extend your holiday, we would be delighted to book accommodation for you!

# Tour character

The route takes you through gently rolling countryside with only a few climbs, although a certain level of basic fitness will enable you to enjoy the countryside and its many attractions all the more. The route runs mainly along cycle paths, service roads and quiet side roads.
