







Basel - Strasbourg

Rhine Cycle Path II


Picturesque Basel is the starting point of our bike tour through the Rhine valley from Basel to Strasbourg. The Rhine has created these landscapes, it leads through fantastic natural landscapes, the impressive heights of the Black Forest always firmly in view, to the Baden wine route and to Freiburg, with its tranquil old town. Colmar, the capital of Alsace wine, is already waiting on the other side of the Rhine. Picturesque and typically French, the little river Lauch and numerous canals flow around the old town. At the foot of the Vosges Mountains, you will cycle along the French Wine Route, through dreamy villages with lots of Alsatian half-timbering and medieval town centers, some of which have been almost completely preserved. Basel and Strasbourg - the two daughters of the Father Rhine - were raised by the Rhine to become true cultural sites.

Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival in Basel

Take some time to explore the colourful variety in the lively city Basel!

Day 2 Basel - Müllheim | approx. 45 km

On the Rhine it is ideal to cycle. Your daily objective is the Markgräfler country.

Day 3 Müllheim - Freiburg | approx. 35 km

After the visit of the villa Urbana and the Maltese's Castle in Heitersheim you will cycle to Bad Krozingen and his Mineral Thermal springs, before you arrive in Freiburg in the Black Forest.

Day 4 Freiburg - Colmar | approx. 60 km

The 13th century Breisach Cathedral towers imposingly over the bank of the Rhine. You cross the Rhine to Neuf-Breisach in Alsace, a 17th century, octagonal fortified town. The day ends wonderfully in the beautiful town of Colmar, one of the most delightful cities on the French wine route.

Day 5 Colmar - Riquewihr/surroundings | approx. 40 km

The villages Eguisheim, Turckheim, Kaysersberg und Riquewihr belong tot he most impressing and famous cities on the French wine route. On easily hilly roads you cycle through the romantic vineyards.

Day 6 Riquewihr/surroundings - Obernai/surroundings | approx. 35-50 km

Along the wine road you will discover the villages of Barr, Andlau and its abbey, Bergheim, Ribeauvillé, Hunawihr. Make a break and taste the local wine!

Day 7**Obernai/surroundings - Strasbourg**

approx. 40-55 km

From there, along the cycle track on the banks of the Bruche canal, you will reach the capital of Europe: Strasbourg.

Day 8**Departure or extension**

Tour character

You will ride mainly on cycle paths, on minor agricultural tarred roads or on little secondary roads without much traffic. Three stages are a little bit hilly.
