The great Lake Constance adventure trip

You will have to look around hard to find another classic cycle path that is as popular as Lake Constance. Three countries participate in the large lake in the heart of Europe. Austria, Germany and Switzerland add a special flair to the lake. This unique symbiosis of various cultures contributed a number of precious treasures of art. To mention only a few of them: Cultural heritage Island Reichenau, baroque style pilgrims church Birnau or the historic old town of Stein on Rhine. Add the marvellous countryside along the lake and a cycle path winding the way through idyllic meadows, along glittering water and in front of the stunning peaks of the Alps.

Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival to Constance

Enjoy a stroll through the very well maintained old town of Constance with council house, the Munster, and the maze of little alleyways of Niederburg. Not to forget the Mediterranean harbour with famous "Imperia". Overnight stay is in Constance.

Day 2 Constance – Gailingen/ Stein am Rhein, approx. 25/35 km + boat trip

Past Wollmatinger Ried you cycle to island Reichenau, UNESCO heritage of nature and culture since 2001. Take a boat to to Gaienhofen and cycle to Gailingen.

Day 3 Excursion Schaffhausen/Rhine Falls approx. 30/50 km

Today you will cycle through a lovely river landscape to Schaffhausen (castle Munot). Afterwards you will visit the Rhine Fall (most powerful waterfall in middle Europe). Overnight stay again in Gailingen.

Day 4 Stein am Rhein – Constance approx. 30/40 km

You will cycle up along the Rhine today back to Stein am Rhein. You pass numerous picturesque Swiss fishing villages on your way back to Constance through the peaceful countryside of the Lower Lake. Napoleon's stepdaughter Hortense de Beauharnais made this area her adopted home. You can visit her former home in Arenenberg, which is now a Napoleon museum.

Day 5 Constance – Radolfzell approx. 30 km

Visit the "flower island" of Mainau! Afterwards you have a short cycle in the direction of Allensbach to Radolfzell.

Day 6 Radolfzell – Uhldingen/Meersburg approx. 35-40 km

A lot of places of interest on your 6th day: monasteries, baroque churches and old castles. Overnight stay in Uhldingen / Meersburg.

Day 7**Uhldingen/Meersburg – Friedrichshafen approx. 25/20 km**

Meersburg, the well known wine growing area, awaits you! You can visit the old castle, which is the oldest inhabited castle in Germany. Further attractions include the new castle with its amazing staircase and the market place which is surrounded by picturesque wooden-framed houses. Accompanied by a beautiful panoramic view of the Alps, you will cycle to Friedrichshafen where you can visit the Zeppelin museum.

Day 8**Friedrichshafen – Bregenz approx. 40 km**

Enjoy the large fruit orchards before you reach the Bavarian metropolis Lindau. Special about Lindau is the protected old town on an island. After a few kilometres you reach Austria and cycle on the lake bank into the Festival Town of Bregenz with the unique lake-stage.

Day 9**Bregenz - Pfänder - St. Gallen, approx. 50 km + train ride**

Near Fußach you reach the Alpine Rhine which you follow to Altstätten. From here you take the train right up into the Appenzellerland and then down through picturesque Swiss countryside to St. Gallen, home to a monastery. You have enough time there to visit the historic centre and the baroque monastery library.

Day 10**Leisure day in St. Gallen**

Today you discover St. Gallen. A short round bike trip or a hike are also good alternatives.

Day 11**St. Gallen - Constance, approx. 45 km**

Downhill to Arbon where you hit the lake again. The route takes you along the banks of the lake through small villages back to Constance.

Day 12**Individual departure or extension of stay**

The route

Very good bike paths, easy to cycle . All important places of interest, which are described in the route book, are included in the tour. On every day you have enough time for sightseeing.
